
DANISH BIOIMAGING NEWSLETTER


Roadmap Infrastructure grant to Danish Biolmaging – 49,7M DKK

In 2020 DBI applied to get on the national roadmap for research infrastructure and was successful. In 2022 the success was fortunately followed up by the Ministy's decision to fund the proposal.

Now the work has begun to make DBI a distributed and multimodal national research infrastructure, ensuring that all life scientists in Denmark have open access to the bioimaging technologies they need to boost excellence in research, education, and innovation.

Tuesday, the consortium held a Kick-off meeting to begin the planning of the infrastructure setup. You can expect a lot more information about the work being done and the possibilities it will give – stay tuned here in the newsletter and on the website.
